LACC is a nonprofit organization that was formed to help save Lake Arrowhead from one of the largest infestations of milfoil in the state of Maine.

Milfoil continues to grow in Lake Arrowhead which interferes with our enjoyment of the lake and devalues our properties.

As a non-profit 501c3 organization, LACC has begun to solicit grants from state and federal levels and is looking for individual contributions in the form of membership dues.

Membership dues for 2010 are \$100 for lakefront property owners and \$50 for all others.

This season promises to be our most robust ever in fighting the Variable Leaf Milfoil in Lake Arrowhead.

LACC will be running three programs simultaneously for the entire season, which begins Monday after Father's Day, June 21st and culminates on Labor Day, September 6th. The three programs are the DASH, the CBI, and the MR programs. Your LACC Board has been busy this winter working hard to secure grant money and donations to help fund these most ambitious programs. We are desperate, however, to get all members to "re-up" this year. All of our grants require some kind of matching dollars. Without your membership money we are literally and figuratively "sunk."

Big news! We've got a second boat. It's a 28-foot pontoon boat with a 85 HP Suzuki outboard. We picked it up with our new scissors-type pontoon boat trailer. We hope to have our second DASH retrofitted, up and running to join her sister vessel, the SS Arrowhead. Our DASH objective this season is to work one vessel exclusively on the feeder streams, Little Ossipee River, Brown Brook, and Little Ossipee Lake Flowage. The other vessel will work the numerous coves, inlets, frontages and boat ramps. We plan to work both vessels five days per week (Mon-Friday).

Our CBI program will begin its eighth year of operation this year. Our inspectors have stopped the exit of more milfoil fragments leaving Lake Arrowhead than all the other CBI programs in the state combined. Our Milfoil Removal Program (MR) will once again concentrate on emplacing and moving benthic barriers, and hand removal efforts. Once installed, these benthic barriers can be easily moved every 8 weeks to eliminate any VLM growing on or near your shorefront.

LACC realizes we won't beat this completely in one year or five years. We expect to manage milfoil over time providing the membership continues to grow. For the Lake's sake, reach out to your neighbors, invite them to join. Whether you are a resident or weekend traveler, homeowner or just own a lot of land in Lake Arrowhead, your resale value and enjoyment of the lake is at risk. Please help by becoming a member!
